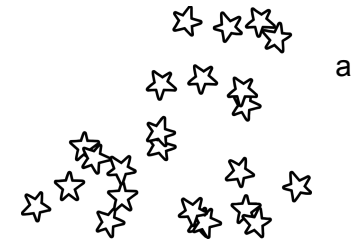
PARKING
