The data is compared to the previous year's data and also some aspirational targets set by EBOR.

Governors on our standards committee were encouraged by the data. Any learning deficits have been identified by the teaching staff and catch up funding is being used to facilitate learning interventions across year groups.

The data gathered enables the governors to hold the school to account for the progress and attainment of the pupils. We look forward to seeing the gradual improvement through the school year.
