UNIFORM SALF

Thank you to everyone who donated items of preloved uniform. Over the holidays we are hoping to organise this and starting in the new school year we will be holding sales during the first week in each month. The uniform is housed in the school bungalow and during the sale days there will be open access from 8am-9am on Monday and Wednesday and 3pm-4pm on Tuesday and Thursdays during

UNIFORM REMINDER

CHANGES TO CHARGES IN SCHOOL

Following our LGB meeting the following price increases will be applied for 1st September. These increases have not been taken lightly and are reflective of our continually rising costs.

School lunches for Year 3-6 £3.00 per day

School clubs will be £4.00 per session

Tiny Steps charge £7.60 per hour (2 year olds)

Nursery change £5.70 per hour (3 year olds)

LATE ARRIVALS

This year we have had changes to our admin team meaning that particularly on a morning there is high demand on Miss Tunley in reception. An audit of punctuality has shown that some days last term there was up to 20 children arriving through reception. This means there is additional demand as some children need to be accompanied to their classrooms. From the start of term the Year 5 door will be open until 9am and late arrivals should be brought to this door rather than in through the main reception area. Children arriving after 9am will receive a late mark and will need to be signed in by parents as the official school start time is 8.50am. Thank you for your support.
